**Pray** specifically thanking God for what he has revealed in his word and asking for the Holy Spirit to help your family live faithfully in light of it.

# Walking Through the Catechism

#### **Question 15:**

Since no one can keep the law, what is its purpose?

That we may know the holy nature and will of God, and the sinful nature and disobedience of our hearts; and thus our need of a Savior. The law also teaches and exhorts us to live a life worthy of our Savior.
